- II. Principal Update – J. Smith: Day 117, 63 remaining, fewer for seniors. This time of year as we focus on preparing for upcoming events (AP, Keystone, Mini-THON, Walk for Clean Water, Proms, Senior events), we also begin to start our planning for next school year (course selection, budget). AP registration window is open again for a short time; we currently will be administering 877 exams in May. Counselor’s will be continuing to visit 10th grade classes to give lessons on self-care. Classroom lessons with 11th graders focused on post-secondary exploration. Guidance is planning on having all 10th graders visit a local college/university to get a firsthand look at a post-secondary campus.
