SCHEDULING INFORMATION

- Student submission of course requests
 - Sign into HAC using YOUR login information
 - Enrollment period: Feb. 19th to Feb. 23rd
 - Teachers will enter recommendations for core subjects, foreign language and band
 - Students can enter 2-3 alternate elective courses
 - Course request tutorial can be found online

SCHEDULING INFORMATION

- You must have a minimum of 7 credits
- Core subjects: English, Foreign Language, Math, Science, Social Studies
- Honors/Non-Honors is recommended by your current teachers
 - Summer reading is a required for CP English 9 Honors
- Courses Not Listed on Course Selection Card:
 - Reading Essentials
 - Math Enrichment
- NCAA Eligibility Requirements

SCHEDULING INFORMATION

- 7 credits = 1 Study Hall every day, all year
 - 7.5 credits = 1 Study Hall every day, half year
 - 8 credits = 0 Study Hall

 - Find a balanced but challenging schedule!
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COURSE CHANGE REQUESTS

- Pick your courses wisely
- Verification sheet will be mailed home
 - This is your opportunity to change/correct courses
- If you need to change a course after verification time:
- Must submit a Course Change Request Form
 - Available 1st day of Summer Recess – 3rd Thursday in July
 - Criteria is very strict
 - Form can be found on HHS website “Course Selection”

COURSE CHANGE REQUESTS

- After the close of the 3rd Thursday in July:
 - Students will have one more chance to submit a Course Change Request form the first 4 days of school

Blended Option

- Offering 27 courses in blended format
- Students required to meet with their HHS teacher every other day for a traditional class session.
- On the day class does not meet, teachers may schedule work sessions, labs, or facilitate individual tutoring in the course.
